

SAFETY & MEDICAL

METAL DETECTORS:

All patrons will pass through metal detectors and bags will be searched. No storage of prohibited items is available at the venue.

- Downtown Las Vegas Events Center (DLVEC)
- 3rd St. Stage on the Fremont Street Experience (FSE)

APPROVED BAGS:

All bags will be searched. Small bags no larger than 14" x 14" permitted Clear plastic, vinyl or PVC bags and doesn't exceed 12" x 6" x 12" One-gallon clear plastic freezer bags Small clutch bags (max 4.5" x 6.5")

PROHIBITED ITEMS:

Illegal substances/paraphernalia Weapons (real or fake) Outside food or beverages Strollers/Wagons/Chairs Coolers Costume Masks Club Colors Glass/Aluminum Containers Amplified Sounds (bullhorns/radios) Pets/animals Smoking Marijuana in Public Bad Vibes

ACCEPTABLE ITEMS:

E-cigs/Vapes/Cigarettes Non-professional Cameras Festival Attire Portable phone charger Hand Sanitizer Good Vibes Totems and other such items may be permitted and will be considered on an individual basis with caveats for overall safety concerns.

MEDICAL SUPPORT:

Medical stations are located throughout the festival grounds with directional signage on the canopy:

- East side near Party Deck in the DLVEC venue
- East side near 3rd & Bridger
- Behind the 1st Street Stage
- Behind the 3rd Street Stage
- 3rd North between Fremont Street Experience and Ogden

Security and local law enforcement will be on-site, with venue staff available to call security or medical teams as needed.

- Downtown Las Vegas Events Center report any suspicious activity or items that need security attention to 702-449-2237 by call or text.

EMERGENCY PROTOCOLS:

In an emergency, the Viva Vision canopy & DLVEC stage will illuminate with more information. Please listen to directions via announcement and/or directions from Security and First Responders. Emergency exits at DLVEC are marked with signage and orange flags.

Respond appropriately by running, hiding, or fighting depending on the emergency.
